

Curriculum Vitae

Mr. Paweł Niedziółka graduated from the Warsaw School of Economics in 1998 with a major in finance and banking. In 2000, he was awarded a doctoral degree in economics at the Collegium of Management and Finance of the Warsaw School of Economics, and in 2010 became an assistant professor. Currently, he is employed at the Institute of Banking of the Warsaw School of Economics as an associate professor, where heads the Financial Risk Management Department. Mr Niedziółka is a member of the Polish Association of Finance and Banking, and the Committee on Financial Sciences of the Polish Academy of Sciences, the Second Prize Winner in the Contest of the President of the National Bank of Poland for the best post-doctoral thesis and the winner of other prizes for his scientific and educational work. He is the author of about 140 scientific publications and a lecturer at bachelor's, master's, postgraduate and PhD courses. Mr Niedziółka is an expert at the Polish Agency for Enterprise Development (PARP), representing the Polish Banks Association, and a lecturer at Polish and International conferences and training courses. Combining his work at the Warsaw School of Economics with practical banking, he manages the Structural Financing Team at Bank Millennium S.A. (previously, he was associated with Credit Lyonnais Bank Polska and Bankgesellschaft Berlin). He has been an independent member of the Supervisory Board of Grupa Kęty S.A. in the years 2014–2020, and in the years 2017–2020 the Deputy Chairman of the Supervisory Board and Chairman of the Nomination and Remuneration Committee.
